Wednesday



Along the Mediterranean

After breakfast, we leave Tel Aviv and head north. Take in the ancient city of Caesarea, built by Herod the Great and once the administrative center of the Roman Empire for the Province of Judaea. The city and its archaeological wonders are a testament to its significance throughout the ages. The ancient port, the Roman hippodrome and amphitheater and the impressive palace are among the many historical treasures in this fascinating ancient city.

The Kibbutz Experience – past and present – visit Ein Shemer Kibbutz Museum, where we will experience a journey from the early days of the kibbutz to the present and learn about the kibbutz way of life. Enjoy a delicious lunch in the kibbutz dining hall.

Continue with a tour of innovation at Kibbutz Magal - visit the Netafim greenhouse innovation center, a pioneering enterprise in the field of drip irrigation technology.

Dinner is included at your hotel.

Thursday



Sea of Galilee and Golan Heights

Drive to the city of Katzrin, the "Capital of the Golan Heights". Walk through a Talmudic village and get a sense of what it was like to live in the times of ancient Israel.

Continue to the mystical city of Tzfat, the birthplace of the ancient Jewish mystical text, the Kabbalah. Stroll through the narrow, winding alleys. Peek inside some of the beautiful synagogues. Browse through workshops and galleries in the flourishing artists' quarter.

Enjoy a tour and wine tasting at local owned boutique winery in the Galilee.

Drive to the Sea of Galilee and take a boat ride on the calm waters.

Dinner is included at your hotel.







Friday



Bahai Gardens, Isfiya Druze Village, Nazareth & Jerusalem

Explore the ancient crusader port city of Akko, the fascinating UNESCO heritage site, with new excavations revealing what life was like 1000 years ago. Visit the Crusader Halls and follow the underground tunnels. See the port and fortifications that enabled the inhabitants of the town to resist invasion by Napoleon Bonaparte. Spend time walking through the Arab Bazaar, reliving a Middle Eastern shopping experience.

Visit the amazing Bahai Gardens in Haifa, comprising a staircase of 19 terraces extending all the way up the northern slope of Mount Carmel. At its heart stands the golden-domed Shrine of the Báb, which is the resting place of the Prophet-Herald of the Bahá'í Faith.

Time permitting

Drive to the Druze village of Dalyet El Carmel, at the top of Mount Carmel. The Druze are Arab-speaking citizens of Israel and are renowned for their hospitality. Take a fascinating tour of the alleys and old quarter of the village.

Drive to Jerusalem and check in at the hotel.

In the evening, experience a special "Shabbat of a Lifetime" dinner, with hospitality in the home of a local Jewish family. Enjoy a traditional meal as you hear about and observe the customs of the Jewish Shabbat.

Saturday



Masada & the Dead Sea

Setting off east from Jerusalem towards the Dead Sea, we shall drive to a lookout point for a view of Wadi Qelt and the cliff-hanging Monastery of St. George; founded in the 5th Century and still active and inhabited by Greek Orthodox monks.

We continue on to the legendary mountaintop plateau of Masada - the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots in their struggle against the Romans in 73CE - overlooking the Dead Sea. Ascending by cable car to the ancient fortress, we shall explore the site, with its synagogue and bathhouse.

Enjoy a leisurely afternoon at the Dead Sea, 1388 feet (423m) below sea level. Cake yourself in mineral-rich mud and float in the buoyant waters.

Lunch is included.

Drive to a lookout point for a view of Wadi Qelt and the cliff hanging Monastery of St George founded in the 5th Century and still active and inhabited by Greek Orthodox monks.

Return to Jerusalem.

In the evening, take in the Sound and Light Show at the Tower of David – a creative depiction of the history of the city of Jerusalem projected onto the ancient stones.







Sunday



Jerusalem - The Old City

Start the day with an overview from the Mt of Olives.

Our exploration of the Old City of Jerusalem begins at the City of David with its fascinating tunnels. See the newest exciting excavations revealing Jerusalem during the time of the 1st Temple period.

Walk through the Old City and visit some of its famous sites, including the Western Wall and the Cardo, an ancient commercial street where you can still shop today.

Walk through the Arab Bazaar and experience traditional Middle Eastern life, with its rich colors, flavors, and smells.

Take a rooftop tour of the Old City neighborhoods, for a behind the scenes look at the various communities living alongside each other in this ancient walled city.

Walk along part of the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. According to traditions dating back to at least the 4th century, the church is the home of the two holiest sites in Christianity: the site where Jesus of Nazareth was crucified, known as "Calvary" or "Golgotha"; and Jesus's empty tomb, where he is said to have been buried and resurrected.

Monday



Jerusalem (and Bethlehem)

Visit Yad Vashem, considered to be the world's primary Holocaust memorial and museum. Take a tour of the new Holocaust History Museum, which occupies over 4,200 square meters, mainly underground. Visit the moving exhibit at the Children's Pavilion, commemorating the death of over 1.5 million Jewish children in the Holocaust.

From Yad Vashem, we will move on to the Israel Museum. There we will see the Dead Sea Scrolls exhibition, and view the famous Model of Jerusalem, depicting the city as it was in the 2nd Temple period.

Optional

Visit Bethlehem. See the Church of the Nativity and the remains of ancient Bethlehem (beneath the Greek Monastery), from the times of Christ.

OR...Leisure time at Mamilla Mall or on Ben Yehuda Street.

Meet up again for a farewell dinner at a local restaurant.







Tuesday

Day 10




Full day tour to Petra

Early morning pick up at your hotel and transfer to the Arava Border Crossing. After ending all border-formalities we drive up to the "Desert Highway" and then to your ultimate destination, the "Rose Red City". Petra is the legacy of the Nabateans who settled in the South of Jordan more than two-thousand years ago.

We enter the ancient city through the famous "Siq" - a narrow natural gorge that made the secret entrance to Petra. The visit begins with an optional short horseback-ride for about 700 m. (*not included*) to the entrance of the Siq, which is about 1.2 km long (walking distance). There is also a possibility to rent a chariot (*not included*) to get inside Petra and back to the gate outside.

At once the valley of Petra opens in front of us, and we see the famous "Khazane" ("Treasury"). Petra was renowned for its massive architecture, pools, dams and water channels. Petra is famous for its huge monuments such as The Treasury, Royal Tombs, The Court, Roman Theatre, Roman Street, Qassier El- Bint (Palace of Pharaoh's daughter) and many other smaller monuments which fascinate visitors. The city itself is almost 45 square km and is considered to be the second wonder of the world.

On the way, if time allows, we will stop for a short visit to Aqaba Then transfer to border around 6 PM, and cross to Eilat, where your transportation to your hotel will wait.







Day 11



Eilat

Enjoy Eilat on your own until time to leave for the airport.



Eilat to Tel Aviv

Transfer to Eilat Airport for your return flight to Tel Aviv. If you are flying home tonight, we will arrange an easy connection to your international flight.
